

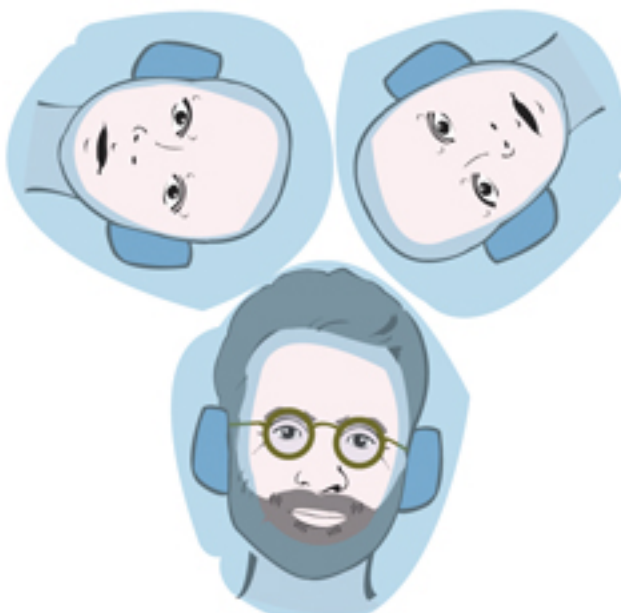
# THE FUTURE SPONSORED BY CNN
